INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS GOING TO RESIDENTIAL CAMPUS

- Eligible students for RS are required to visit BRAC University website: (www. bracu.ac.bd/academics/residential-campus) and download/print the RS Handbook. The handbook will be available from January 14, 2024.
- 2. Students should collect Payment Slip from usis.bracu.ac.bd (From student's own account)
- 3. Students must complete payments through bank deposits.
- 4. Health Check-up is mandatory for all RS students, which will take place in the Medical Centre at 1st floor at New Campus from January 14 to January 18, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Health card will be provided at this stage.
- 5. Students must submit the **fully completed RS Forms I, II & III** along with original health card, five copies of passport size photos and grade sheet to the staff available in **Room No: 07A-06C and 07A-07C at New Campus** at Badda **from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on January 15 to January 17, 2024**.
- 6. Transport will leave from the New Campus at Badda to Residential Campus on Friday, January 19, 2024 at 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m. for the female students and from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. for the male students. Students will not be allowed to avail BRAC University transports or enter BRAC University Residential Campus without wearing or showing their ID Cards.
- 7. Student's must **Reach and Report to Residential Campus from 10 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. on Friday, January 19, 2024** and they must register their names according to their allocated dormitory.
- 8. Students are required to attend Campus Orientation at 10.00 a.m. on Saturday, January 20, 2024 at Anandapur, Residential Campus.
- 9. Classes will begin in person on Sunday, January 21, 2024.


