

Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship Policy



The Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship is a fully funded, **100%** scholarship for exceptional students at Brac University. This is a four-year scholarship eligible to incoming undergraduate students. Students who have demonstrated extraordinary talent are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Examples of excellence include medals in national and international olympiads, publishing high quality papers, manuscripts, literary works, etc.

Requirements:

- Applicants in the sciences and computer science will be expected to have participated in the national training camp of olympiads such as the Bangladesh Mathematical Olympiad, Bangladesh Physics Olympiad, Bangladesh Olympiad in Informatics, Bangladesh Biology Olympiad, or other reputed Olympiads. Publication of high-quality scientific papers is also appreciated.
- Applicants in the social sciences and arts are expected to have published either manuscripts, books or substantial publications. Applicants from other fields must have demonstrated similar exceptional achievement in their respective fields.
- Applicants must pursue an undergraduate degree at Brac University.
- Applicants must complete their Higher Secondary Certificate or A-level education.
- Students with extraordinary achievements even without an Olympiad background can apply.

How to apply:

- Applicants must submit an application through an online form where they will submit their academic transcripts, Olympiad and training camp participation certificates, and a personal statement along with other necessary documents.

- Selected applicants are required to undergo multi-part intensive viva interviews.
- Applicants must go through the standard admission process of Brac University and attend the admission test.

Terms and conditions:

- Recipients of the scholarship will be awarded a full tuition waiver that includes the residential semester fees and other fees. However, the scholarship does not include coverage for living expenses or personal costs.
- Recipients will receive support for a period of 4 years, i.e., 12 semesters.
- Recipients will not be subject to any credit restrictions during their scholarship period.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum **CGPA of 3.25 on a scale of 4.00** in their academic program.
- Recipients must self-pay for any courses that are retaken/repeated.
- Recipients should submit a self-evaluation after the midterm period of every semester.
- If a recipient drops a semester for a valid reason that semester will not be counted as part of the 12-semester span of the Scholarship. However, a proper justification must be submitted to the Chairperson of the scholarship committee with valid documents.
- In the event that a candidate fails to maintain the necessary CGPA (3.25 out of 4.00), they will be given two consecutive semesters to raise their CGPA to the required level. Their scholarship will remain intact during these two semesters. If they fail to raise their CGPA to the required level within this timeframe, their Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship shall lapse.
- The Scholarship will be terminated upon the discovery of any false or misleading information with regard to admissions-related documentation. Students who violate Brac University's code of conduct may also have their scholarship revoked. The Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship Committee shall discuss cases of violations of policy. In exceptional circumstances, the committee may recommend that the scholarship be retained. This decision must be approved by the Chairperson of the scholarship committee.
- Replacements/additions/removals from the Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship Committee will occur through nomination/initiation by the Chairperson of the Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship Committee and majority voting approval on the nominated individual by the members and chairperson of the committee.
- The Sir Fazle Hasan Abed Scholarship Committee may change the scholarship policy and eligibility criteria from time to time based on the availability of funds. The Scholarship Committee will endeavor to give advance notice of changes.
